FISHING

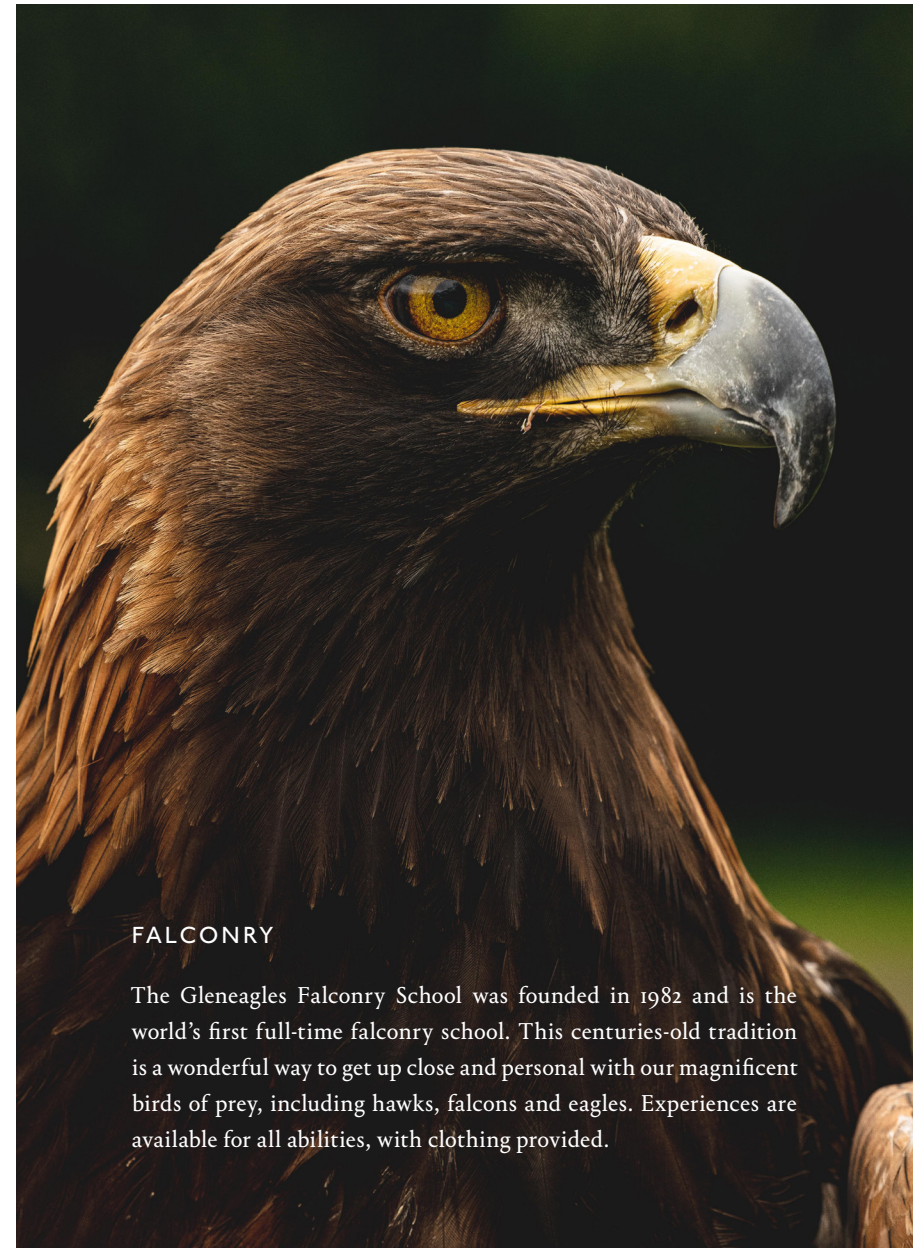
