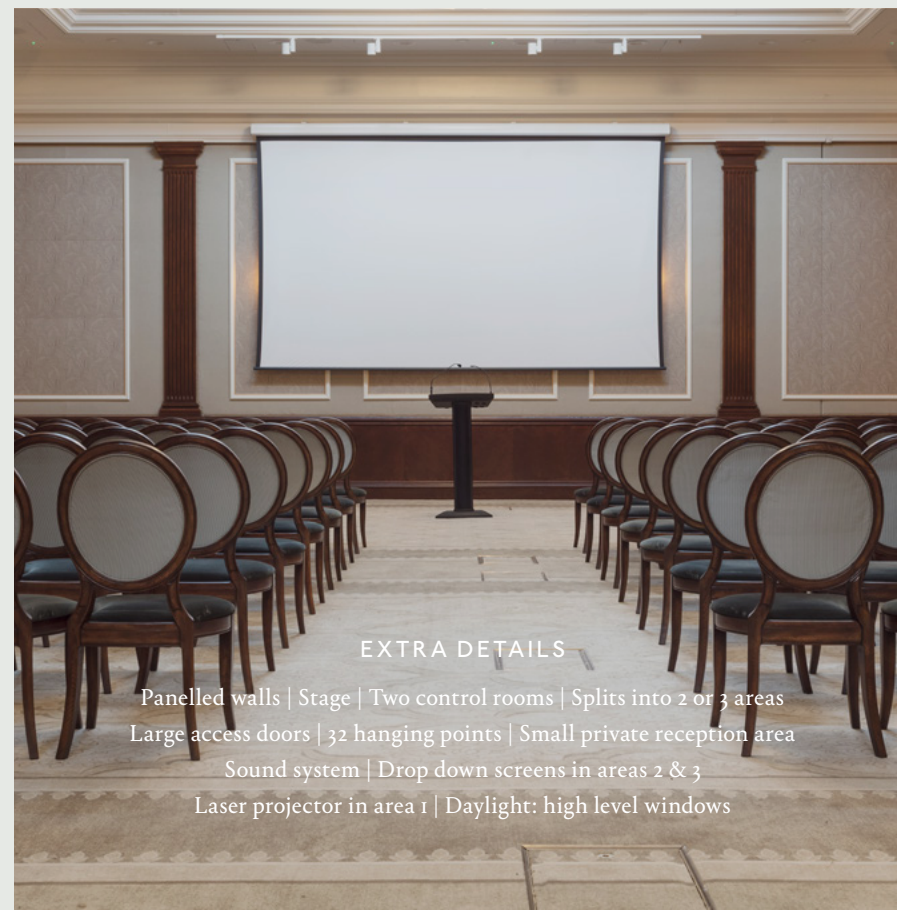
The Henry Hall
